Here are a few important things you should know about your new puppy –

- 1** – They are still babies! Do not expect them to know the rules of the house right away. They need time to adjust to their new environment, diet and housemates before they are fully integrated into the home.
- 2** – Housetraining is not just training the puppy – it is just as much training the humans in the house! Be consistent with routines and rewards for your puppy.
- 3** – As much as you want to take your puppy out and about to show him/her off – DONT! Keep him/her isolated at home as much possible until their vaccine series is complete. Parvo virus is a hardy virus and lives in the environment for months at a time.
- 4** – Teach your puppy it is okay to be handled! Play with their feet and ears often. This will make exams and toenail trims easier on them as they get older!

Included in your new puppy pack is a zip drive. This zip drive has been LOADED with a lot of resourceful information on puppies! There is information on there regarding vaccines, zoonotic disease, training and much much more!
